

Notice of Reporting Requirement Not Met

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

[Village of Hordville] was required to develop and submit an initial service line inventory including all service lines connected to the public water distribution system and describe the materials of those service lines. Our system failed to submit an initial inventory of service lines to the Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy by October 16, 2024.
